A NUMBER of Twelfth parades are to go ahead on Monday in South Belfast – and all eyes will be on the marches to see if an Orange Order plea for followers to remain at home is heeded.

The parades will take place on Monday, July 13 as Twelfth

celebrations are not permitted to be held on a Sunday.

The Orange Order cancelled the Twelfth entirely at the height of the Covid pandemic, but after a number of lockdown restrictions were eased, applications to the Parades Commission began to

come thick and fast. District parades that have been given the go-ahead will be limited to 30 participants.

The main South Belfast parades will be at Ballynafeigh in the Ormeau area and at Finaghy.
